The proposal for a new development at **317 Finchley Road** (the former pub next to the Overground station) will be discussed at a Council organised Development Management Forum on Wednesday 16th March, 7-9pm at the JW3 Centre - details here/beta/40/2016/

The Council's proposals to close the community centre at **96-98 Shoot-Up Hill** and convert it into private housing is ref: <u>2016/0697/P</u> (*comments by Wednesday 16th March*). The site is protected for community use in the Neighbourhood Plan and the NDF is working with the groups who use the centre to oppose the plans.

The **Kilburn** neighbourhood forum is applying for designation from Camden & Brent Councils - details, including a map of the area, can be seen here.

A reminder that the Council is seeking comments as part of the second consultation on the **new Local Plan** - the main planning document for the borough. Details <u>here</u> (*deadline for responses is Monday 4th April*).

A very big thank you to everyone who responded to the survey about **The Alliance** - there were 800 responses, the vast majority of which were positive - with 99% agreeing that the pub is an 'asset of community value'. We're due to hear about the outcome of our ACV application in the next few weeks - when we have news, we'll post it on our <u>Twitter</u> account.
